To: Domestic Waste Haulers

Subject: Applying for Domestic Waste Hauler Permit

This letter contains information to apply for domestic waste discharge permit and dispose of hauled domestic wastes to the Inland Empire Utilities Agency (IEUA) treatment plant. The following items are required:

1. Permit application (form attached) and non-refundable permit processing fee as noted in the most current Domestic Waste Hauler Rate Resolution (Resolution);
2. Copy of your Liquid Waste Hauling/Disposal permit issued by the Department of Public Health of the County of San Bernardino (as Attachment A); and
3. Copy of your current Certificate of Liability Insurance (as Attachment B) showing:
 - a. General Liability,
 - b. Automobile Liability,
 - c. Workers Compensation and Employer's Liability, and
 - d. Inland Empire Utilities Agency, in the certificate holder's box (left bottom of certificate).

Please mail all above items to Inland Empire Utilities Agency, P.O. Box 9020, Chino Hills, CA 91709. If preferred, you can hand deliver them to our office at 6075 Kimball Avenue, Chino, CA 91710.

Our acceptance of the application and processing fee does not guarantee permit issuance. If you are granted a permit, you will be required to submit a manifest for each domestic wastewater dump. Several manifest forms are provided as a courtesy when the permit is issued. After that they must be purchased (\$0.09 each) at our disposal location, Regional Treatment Plant No. 1, 2662 E. Walnut St., Ontario, CA 91761.

Please be informed that we only accept domestic wastes generated within the IEUA service area, which includes the Cities of Chino, Chino Hills, Fontana, Montclair, Ontario, Rancho Cucamonga, and Upland. Any domestic wastewater generated outside the specified cities and domestic wastes mixed with any other kinds of wastes will not be accepted. The volumetric dump fee is specified on the attached Resolution and is subject to change in July each year. Discharges of domestic wastes at the IEUA facility must be in compliance with requirements stated in our Regional Wastewater Ordinance No. 82 (<http://www.ieua.org/Pretreatment/ordinance.html>).
