

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-3-2

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE INLAND EMPIRE UTILITIES AGENCY*, SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING RATES COVERING THE SALE OF RECYCLED WATER FOR FISCAL YEAR 2007/08

WHEREAS, The Regional Advisory Committees have reviewed and recommended service rates for Fiscal Year 2007/08:


NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of the Inland Empire Utilities Agency* does hereby RESOLVE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER as follows:

That effective July 1, 2007, the sale of recycled water under the terms of Ordinance 69 that is available to our Contracting Agencies from the Tertiary Treatment Plants shall be \$193.40 per million gallons or \$63.00 per acre foot.

That effective July 1, 2008, the sale of recycled water under the terms of Ordinance 69 that is available to our Contracting Agencies from the Tertiary Treatment Plants shall be \$202.60 per million gallons or \$66.00 per acre foot.


Upon the effective date of this Resolution, Resolution No. 2006-6-8 is hereby rescinded in their entirety.
