F. MATERIALS AND RESOURCES

1.0 Construction Waste Management

Materials and Resources Credits 2.1-2.2: 2 (two) points

Objective: To divert construction, demolition, and land clearing debris from landfill disposal and redirect recyclable material back to the manufacturing process.

Narrative: The project has achieved a 77% diversion of construction-generated waste from landfill. This was achieved through on-site separation of concrete, wood, metal, cardboard, paper and plastic. TG Construction sub-contracted with Waste Management Inland Empire, for waste hauling and materials recycling.

Projects and Activities: A waste management plan was developed and implemented to quantify material diversion by weight. (Salvage included donation materials to charitable organizations such as Habitat for Humanity) At least 50% (by weight) of construction, demolition, and land clearing waste were recycled and/or salvaged.

2.0 Recycled Content

Materials and Resources Credits 4.1-4.2: 2 (two) points

Objective: To increase demand for building products that have incorporated recycled content material, reducing the impacts resulting from extraction of new materials.

Narrative: The materials specified for and installed on the project were selected for their high level of recycled content. As a result, the project has achieved a 90% recycled content value overall. The values indicated on the calculation spreadsheet (Attachment 'J') were obtained from TG Construction's schedule of values for the project. See Attachment 'K' for certification letters from each manufacturer/supplier, listing the overall recycled content that has been provided for each of the materials tracked under this credit.

Projects and Activities: A minimum of 20% of building materials were manufactured regionally within a radius of 500 miles of the project area. A minimum of 25% of building materials contained in aggregate, a minimum weighted average of 20% post-consumer recycled content material, or, a minimum weighted average 40% post-industrial recycled content material.

3.0 Local/Regional Materials, 20% Manufactured Locally

Materials and Resources Credit 5.1: 1 (one) point

Objective: To increase demand for building products that are manufactured locally, thereby reducing the environmental impacts resulting from transportation, and supporting the local economy.

Narrative: The project was designed and constructed using local and regional manufacturers and materials for many of the construction materials. As a result, the project has achieved 67% locally manufactured materials overall. The values indicated on the attached calculation spreadsheet were obtained from TG Construction's schedule of values (see Attachment 'L').

Certification letters from each manufacturer/supplier, listing, location of manufacture and harvest, have been provided for each of the materials tracked under this credit (see Attachment 'M').

Projects and Activities: A minimum of 20% of building materials were manufactured regionally within a radius of 500 miles.

4.0 Local/Regional Materials, 50% Harvested/Extracted Locally

Materials and Resources Credit 5.2: 1 (one) point

Objective: To increase demand for building products that are manufactured locally, thereby reducing the environmental impacts resulting from transportation, and supporting the local economy.

Narrative: The project was designed and constructed using local and regional manufacturers and materials for many of the construction materials.

Eighty-nine percent of the locally manufactured products were made from raw materials harvested, recovered, or extracted within a 500-mile radius of the project site. The use of concrete tilt-up construction (from local source batch plants), locally manufactured gypsum drywall, and locally harvested landscape materials greatly influenced the performance of this project.

Projects and Activities: Of these regionally manufactured materials, a minimum of 50% were extracted, harvested, or recovered within 500 miles.
