THE INLAND EMPIRE UTILITIES AGENCY HOSTS 2014 WATER IS LIFE TRAVELING ART SHOW

Chino, California – The Inland Empire Utilities Agency (IEUA) will host the 2014 Metropolitan Water District of Southern California (MWD) *Water is Life* Traveling Student Art Show February 6-13 at the IEUA headquarters located at 6075 Kimball Avenue. The winning posters will be available for public viewing during regular business hours: 8 a.m. – 5 p.m., Monday through Thursday and 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Friday. The exhibit will feature winning posters from IEUA's service area along with other creative and colorful award-winning student artwork.

Students in grades K-12 throughout the region submitted their water-themed art in school year 2012-2013. The *Water is Life* student art poster contest encourages students to create artistic posters using water-wise messaging while depicting various water uses. Out of 159 student entries 36 winning posters were selected to be published in the 2014 MWD calendar.

"It is important for students within our community to understand water issues and be able to identify how to use water wisely. This art contest enables students to use their creativity while sending a message relaying the importance of water," said Terry Catlin, IEUA Board President.
