Pre-Qualification of Contractors

•IEUA utilizes a pre-qualification process for bidding all public works projects. Information regarding pre-qualficaiton can be accessed through PlanetBids at https://www.planetbids.com/portal/portal.cfm?CompanyID=27411.

Request For Proposals (Design Consulting Engineers)

• Engineering designs are solicited through a Request for Proposal on a project-by-project basis either through an advertisement sent through PlanetBids or to the list of consultants currently on IEUA's master design service contact list. *The next solicitation to be added to the master list will be Spring 2018.*

Projects Under \$2 Million (Contractors)

• Projects under \$2 million consist of a pool of contractors separated by trade. Contractors can be added on a biannual basis (odd year) by submitting a prequalification package. Notification of prequalification advertisement is sent through PlanetBids. *The next solicitation will be Spring 2017.*

Projects Larger than \$2 Million (Contractors)

• Projects larger than \$2 million have a separate prequalification issued based on the project scope. *Current and future RFQ's can be found on PlanetBids.*

Minor Construction Projects (Contractors)

• Minor construction projects are solicited through a Request for Proposal to the list of qualified contractors. Contractors can be added to the list on a bi-annual basis (odd year) by submitting a prequalification package. Notification of prequalification advertisement is sent through PlantBids. *The next solicitation to be added to the list will be Spring 2017.*

Emergency Construction Projects (Contractors)

• Emergency construction projects have three different levels of urgency. Requests are issued to a qualified list of contractors via email. Contractors can be added to the list on a bi-annual basis (odd year) by submitting a prequalification package. Notification of prequalification advertisement is sent through PlantBids. *The next solicitation to be added to the list will be Spring 2017.*

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
