CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY ON GALLOPING HILLS ROAD

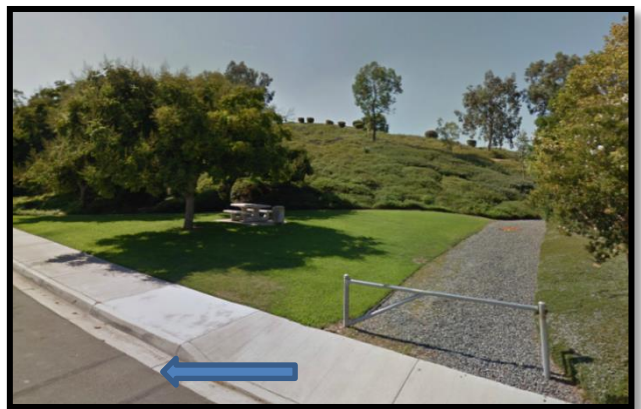
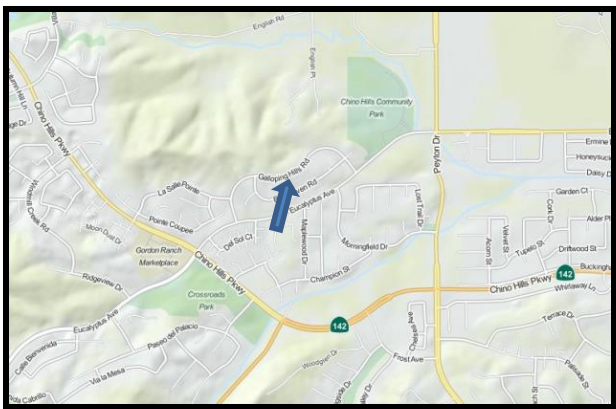
WHAT: Construction activity will take place on Galloping Hills Road. Traffic will be permitted in both directions. Two flagmen will be onsite controlling the flow of traffic. Commuters can expect traffic delays. Please obey “No Parking” signs.

WHEN: Thursday, May 15, 2014 through Friday, May 16, 2014

WHERE: Galloping Hills Road near the 2800 block and adjacent to the emergency access road entrance.

WORK HOURS: 8:30 am – 4:00 pm

IMPACTS: Expect traffic delays up to 10 minutes.



Benefiting the residents and businesses of Chino Hills and Chino, this project will provide recycled water as an additional source of water for landscape irrigation use and groundwater recharge. This project will save approximately 90 million-gallons per year of drinking water, while helping to drought proof IEUA’s service area and keeping the cost of water low, providing a reliable source of alternative water. *Funding for this project has been provided in full or in part through an agreement with the State Water Resources Control Board and the Environmental Protection Agency.
