It is recommended that the Committee/Board:

- 1. Adopt an Addendum to the Facilities Master Plan Program Environmental Impact Report; and
- 2. Authorize the General Manager to file the Notice of Determination with the San Bernardino County Clerk of the Board.

D. <u>RP-1 DIGESTER NO. 4 COATING REPAIR PROJECT</u>

It is recommended that the Committee/Board:

- Award the service contract to repair the internal coating of Digester No. 4 for Regional Water Recycling Plant No. 1 (RP-1), to Industrial Coatings and Restoration Services, for a not-to-exceed amount of \$158,390 including sales tax, payment and performance bond, and contingency cost; and
- 2. Authorize the General Manager to execute the contract.
