<u>ADDITIONS TO THE AGENDA</u>

- 2. After closing the Public Hearing, adopt Ordinance No. 97.

It is recommended that the Board approve the total disbursements for the month of August 2014, in the amount of \$19,384,983.15.

C. <u>REGIONAL WATER RECYCLING PLANT NO. 4 CONTROLNET</u> REPLACEMENT

It is recommended that the Board approve the sole source purchase of Rockwell Automation hardware for a not-to-exceed amount of \$85,000.

D. <u>AGREEMENT BETWEEN IEUA AND SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY</u> FOR RECYCLED WATER, SEWER, AND O&M SERVICES

It is recommended that the Board:

- Approve the proposed agreement between IEUA and San Bernardino County for recycled water, sewer, and O&M services; and
- 2. Authorize the General Manager to execute the agreement.

It is recommended that the Board approve the Agency's Regional Wastewater System *Enforcement Response Plan*, which establishes procedures for consistent and reasonable enforcement response to industrial users' non-compliance with wastewater Ordinance and permit requirements.

F. <u>CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SUPPORT SERVICES CONTRACT AMENDMENT</u>

It is recommended that the Board:

- Approve Contract Amendment No. 4600001141-003 to GK & Associates for construction management services for a one-year contract extension through January 2016, for a not-to-exceed total amount of \$1,000,000; and
- 2. Authorize the General Manager to execute the contract amendment.
