## <u>AUTHORIZING THE REDEMPTION OF CHINO BASIN REGIONAL FINANCING AUTHORITY REVENUE BONDS, SERIES 2005A</u>

Manager of Finance and Accounting Javier Chagoyen-Lazaro presented the information on the redemption of the Chino Basin Regional Financing Authority Revenue Bonds, Series 2005A. He stated that in July 2013, the Agency Board of Director approved the designation of \$4.15 million from the "one-time" Redevelopment Tax receipts to fund the early retirement of the last two installments of 2005A Bonds scheduled to mature on November 1, 2021 (\$2.03 million) and November 1, 2022 (\$2.12 Million). He stated it was later determined that early retirement of the remaining full principal amount of \$14,695,000, would result in an additional costs savings of \$3.2 million in avoided future interest payments. Mr. Chagoyen-Lazaro stated that early retirement of the full outstanding principal amount was presented to the Board as part of a series of budget workshops facilitated between January and March 2014, and was included in the Agency's FY 2015-2019 Strategic Plan and FY 2014/15 Budget adopted on June 18, 2014. He further reported that at today's (October 1), IEUA Board meeting, staff will recommend that the Board adopt Resolution No. 2014-10-1, authorizing the redemption of Chino Basin Regional Financing Authority Revenue Bonds, Series 2005A

With no further business, President Catlin adjourned the meeting at 10:09 a.m.

#### RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended the Board of Directors:

- 1. Hold a Public Hearing to receive public comments prior to the adoption of Resolution No. 2015-1-1, establishing capacity charges, volumetric charges, strength charges, Agency program charges, and application fees for the Non-Reclaimable Wastewater System (NRWS) for Fiscal Year 2014/15; and
- 2. After closing the Public Hearing, adopt Resolution No. 2015-1-1.

#### BACKGROUND

The Inland Empire Utilities Agency (IEUA) negotiated a new NRWS agreement (Agreement No. 4830) with the County Sanitation District of Los Angeles County (CSDLAC) effective July 1, 2014, to replace Agreement No. 1679 which would have expired in 2018. The new agreement and its rate structure eliminated the surcharge threshold levels for total suspended solids and chemical oxygen demand. IEUA is now responsible for all the solids discharged by the NRWS industries as measured at the East End monitoring station, including the difference between East End and the sum of the industrial dischargers.

To distribute the solids difference fairly and equitably to the industries, IEUA retained the services of Trussell Technologies who conducted the NRWS Solids Imbalance Study

in 2013/14. The study resulted in the development of a preliminary solids imbalance distribution equation (Eq. 1):

The industries were informed of this ongoing study through several workshops and that the equation Eq. 1 would be revised as more data was collected. As a result, a revised equation (Eq. 2) was finalized for Fiscal Year 2014/15 with only a slight modification to the coefficients:

The revised equation Eq. 2 was not reflected in the current Rate Resolution 2014-06-04. However, the rate structure, budget forecast, rate model, and billings for the Fiscal Year 2014/15 first quarter's strength imbalance charges were all based on the revised equation (Eq. 2). The adoption of Resolution No. 2015-1-1 will reflect the revised coefficients for the solids imbalance distribution.

The NRWS Rate Resolution is consistent with the Agency's Business Goal of Fiscal Responsibility in providing open and transparent communication while ensuring the Agency's fiscal health.

#### RESOLUTION NO. 2015-1-1

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE **INLAND EMPIRE UTILITIES** AGENCY\*, BERNARDINO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING CAPACITY CHARGES, **VOLUMETRIC** CHARGES. STRENGTH CHARGES, AGENCY PROGRAM CHARGES, AND APPLICATION FEES **FOR** THE RECLAIMABLE WASTEWATER SYSTEM (NRWS) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014/15

- **WHEREAS**, NRWS *Wastewater Disposal Agreement 4830* has been adopted between CSDLAC and IEUA effective July 1, 2014;
- WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish a rate structure for the collection of costs associated for the sewerage service under this new Agreement;
- **WHEREAS**, it is necessary to allocate User with Non Reclaimable Wastewater System Capacity Unit (NRWSCU), in order to collect such charges;
- **WHEREAS**, it is necessary to allocate individual Users their fractional contribution of the Solids Discrepancy at East End monitoring facility  $(SD_{EE})$  determined by the *Fractional Solids Discrepancy*  $(FSD_i)$  formula;
- **WHEREAS**, it is necessary to establish application fees for processing applications for NRWSCU Allocations and Wastewater Discharge Permits for the use of the Inland Empire Utilities Agency (Agency)'s NRWS;
- WHEREAS, under Section 13550, et seq., of the California Water Code, a Public Agency may require industries to use recycled water for certain purposes, where it is available and at reasonable cost;
- **WHEREAS**, the Board of Directors of the Agency, pursuant to Ordinance No. 99, may establish said fees and charges by Resolution;
- **NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of Directors hereby RESOLVES, DETERMINES, AND ORDERS the following to be effective retroactive to July 1, 2014

#### <u>Section 1</u> That the acquisition of wastewater discharge right shall be as follows:

#### (A) NRWSCU ACQUISITION RATES

1. A NRWSCU for the NRWS is determined by the following formula:

NRWSCU

- 2. The minimum number of NRWSCU shall be 25 NRWSCU.
- 3. The **purchase rate** for the right to discharge one (1) NRWSCU shall be \$5,000 per NRWSCU.
- 4. The optional **annual lease rate** for the right to discharge one (1) NRWSCU shall be 5% per year of the purchase rate.

The above charges shall be paid in full upon the execution of the NRWSCU purchase or lease.

#### Section 2 That the monthly charges for discharge to the NRWS are:

#### (A) VOLUMETRIC CHARGES

For discharge to the NRWS, the monthly volumetric charge is \$835.80 per million gallons of discharge.

#### (B) PEAK FLOW CHARGES

For discharge to the NRWS, the monthly Peak Flow (PF) Charge shall be determined by the following formula:

$$PF\ Charge = 0.7526\ x\ PF_{(gpm)}x\ PF\ charge\ rate$$

Where:

$$PF_{(gpm)} = \frac{Flow (in gallons per month)}{262,800}$$

The *PF charge rate* shall be \$110.88 per Peak Flow rate in peak gallons per minute (*pgpm*) or \$317.54 per million gallons of volumetric discharge.

#### (C) STRENGTH CHARGES

That Strength Charges are for excessive Chemical Oxygen Demand (COD) and Total Suspended Solids (TSS) and are applicable to all discharges to the NRWS. The rates are as follows:

<u>PARAMETER</u>	<u>RATE</u>
COD	\$147.84 per 1,000 pounds (dry weight)
TSS	\$418.22 per 1,000 pounds (dry weight)

Strength charges for the NRWS discharges are calculated from the average of all the samples collected during the calendar month and invoiced on a quarterly basis. If there is no sample data for a given month, strength charges for that month shall be determined by using the average of all available data within the billing quarter.

#### (D) SOLIDS DISCREPANCY CHARGE FOR NRWS

Solids Discrepancy Charge for an industry  $(SDC_i)$  shall be calculated on a monthly basis and invoiced on a quarterly basis. The charge shall be calculated by multiplying the individual industry's *Fractional Solids Discrepancy*  $(FSD_i)$  by the Total Solids Discrepancy at East End monitoring facility  $(TSD_{EE})$  and by TSS rate:

$$SDC_i = (FSD_i) \ x \ (TSD_{EE}) \ x \ (TSS \ rate)$$

Individual industry's  $FSD_i$  for the NRWS is determined by the  $FSD_i$  formula to allocate the individual industry's solids contribution to the total solids discrepancy, based on their contribution to the overall loading of Alkalinity, Biological Oxygen Demand (BOD), Dissolved Calcium, and Flow.

$$FSD_i = 0.086 \ x \left[ \frac{Alk_i}{Alk_T} \right] + 0.541 \ x \left[ \frac{BOD_i}{BOD_T} \right] + 0.057 \ x \left[ \frac{Ca_i}{Ca_T} \right] + 0.316 \ x \left[ \frac{Flow_i}{Flow_T} \right]$$

 $FSD_i$ = Fractional Solids Discrepancy for individual discharger (i)

 $Alk_i$  = Individual dissolved alkalinity loading to the NRWS for discharger (i)

 $Alk_T$  = Combined dissolved alkalinity loading from all dischargers to the NRWS

 $BOD_i = \text{Individual BOD}_5 \text{ loading to the NRWS for discharger } (i)$ 

 $BOD_T$  = Combined BOD<sub>5</sub> loading from all dischargers to the NRWS

 $Ca_i$  = Individual dissolved calcium loading to the NRWS for discharger (i)

 $Ca_T$  = Combine dissolved calcium loading from all dischargers to the NRWS

All the CSDLAC rates include the ad valorem charges.

#### (E) AGENCY CIP AND O&M CHARGES

The Agency's CIP and O&M charges shall be \$17.87 per NRWSCU per month.

#### (F) 4R DEFERRED CAPITAL CHARGES

The deferred 4R capital charges shall be \$212.60 per NRWSCU per month as assigned per Agreement 1679.

#### (G) RECYCLED WATER USAGE CREDIT

This program is for recycled water (RW) Users and shall end when funding is exhausted or not later than June 30, 2024, whichever comes first. New Users who qualify for this program shall be given the recycled water credit in effect at the time of connection to the RW system.

For Fiscal Year 14-15, the Recycled Water Usage Credit is \$445.02 per million gallons of recycled water used.

#### Section 3 OTHER CHARGES

IEUA will pass on any other charges from CSDLAC invoiced to the Agency to dischargers to the NRWS, such as, but not limited to, flow and strength imbalance charges, permit, inspection, analytical fees, etc.

Section 4 That Application fee for a NRWS Capacity Unit Purchase or Annual Lease shall be: \$ 200.00

## 2. PUBLIC HEARING AND ADOPTION OF RESOLUTION NO. 2014-1-3, ADOPTING AMENDMENT TO THE IEUA CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE

President Catlin called the Public Hearing to order. President Catlin stated that the purpose of the hearing is to provide the public an opportunity to submit comments on the proposed Resolution No. 2014-1-3, adopting amendment to the IEUA Conflict of Interest Code.

General Counsel Jean Cihigoyenetche provided a brief overview of the amendment to the IEUA Conflict of Interest Code. As dictated by law, every two years the Agency must reevaluate this code to ensure it is up to date. The changes include adjustments to job titles, and eliminating titles that are no longer being utilized by the Agency. Secondly, if there have been changes in financial authorization for Agency departments. Lastly, the changes include general housekeeping modifications to the Conflict of Interest Code. The law requires that any employees working for the Agency having decision making authority with a material financial effect on the Agency must fill out an annual disclosure form 700 that sets forth their financial interests so that the public may see what their personal financial interests are. He stated that the Agency has set the limit at \$15,000, meaning that all employees that have the authority to expend \$15,000 on behalf of the Agency must complete the Conflict of Interest Statement each year. Mr. Cihigoyenetche stated that he is requesting to hold a public hearing and enact the amendment to the IEUA Conflict of Interest Code so that it may be submitted to the County of San Bernardino. Mr. Cihigoyenetche stated that no comments were received.

Questions from the committees have been addressed. Acting Manager of Engineering Majid Karim gave an overview of the Wineville Extension Recycled Water Pipeline Segment B, proposed value engineering. He stated that the construction contract was awarded to Mike Bubalo Construction on May 21, 2014 for a total of \$8.9 million. Mr. Karim stated that the proposed value engineering would relocate a section of the pipeline to an SCE easement. The reassignment would shorten the pipeline by 2,500 linear feet. The property acquisition process is underway; the sale of the land must be approved by the State Department of Finance. Lastly, Mr. Karim reviewed the proposed schedule.

It is also required that the report be reviewed by an external auditor. The Agency contracted White Nelson Diehl Evans (WNDE) to complete the external financial audit. WNDE provided an unmodified opinion; this is the best opinion that can be provided. Internal Audit also provides an additional quality control review, ensuring the financial statements are appropriate submitted to the appropriate parties. Audit Committee Financial Advisor Travis Hickey gave a brief overview of the WNDE opinion and the Agencies responsibilities. Manager of Finance and Accounting Javier Chagoyen-Lazaro provided an overview of the CAFR financial statements, stating that revenue and funding sources were down by approximately seven percent. Total expenses were 30.5% higher primarily due to the retirement of intangible capacity rights resulting from the early renegotiation of the Non-Reclaimable north system with Los Angeles County Department of Sanitation. Mr. Chagoyen-Lazaro closed by providing the overall FY 2013/14 cash position of \$148 million; slightly higher than FY 2012/13 of \$145 million.

General Counsel Jean Cihigoyenetche stated that his findings are unqualified that under government code 1090, unpermitted interest in contract President Catlin had no conflict of interest and was free to discuss and participate in the voting of this matter. Primarily the conflict is overcome by the fact that President Catlin's salary from the WFA (Water Financing Authority), is from another public agency. Executive Manager of Engineering Chris Berch gave a PowerPoint presentation on the MWD purchase order terms. He stated that on November 18, 2014, the MWD Board approved the purchase order terms. Based on these new terms the preferred option of the Agency is to enter into a new tenyear purchase order with MWD, effective January 1, 2015, the purchase order will allow the agency to secure 932,830 acre feet of water from MWD at a secured rate. The financial commitment of the Agency would be to purchase 398,350 acre feet over the next ten years. Additionally, the Agency has purchase agreements with Cucamonga Valley Water District, Water Financing Authority and Fontana Water Company that bind each member agency to the terms and conditions set forth in the purchase order between IEUA and MWD. Going forward, IEUA recommends establishing the individual tier 1 allocations by resolution. Additionally, provisions will be included in the Resolution to allow IEUA to reduce Tier 1 allocations to its member agencies as a result of a water supply allocation plan (WSAP), imposed by MWD and invoice Tier 2 rates for fiscal year

purchases in excess of allocation. In closing, Mr. Berch gave an overview of the member agencies purchase agreement amount by acre feet per year.

In addition to the general disbursements mentioned above, the Agency disbursed \$19.7 million from the debt service restricted accounts. From this amount, \$14.7 million was directed to the early redemption of the Chino Basin Regional Financing Authority Revenue Bonds, series 2005A (Inland Empire Utilities Agency), (2005A) bonds, as approved by the Board in the FY 2014/15 Adopted Budget. The remaining amount was allocated to scheduled debt service payments of the 2005A bonds (\$1.9 million) and the Chino Basin Regional Financing Authority Revenue Bonds, Series 2008A (Inland Empire Utilities Agency) (2008A) and Chino Basin Regional Financing Authority Revenue Bonds, Series 2008B (Inland Empire Utilities Agency) (2008B) bonds (\$3.1 million).

The Financial Affairs report is consistent with the Agency's Business Goal of Fiscal Responsibility in providing financial reporting that accounts for general disbursements associated with operating requirements.

## **RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the Board of Directors adopt Resolution No. 2015-1-2, approving an amendment to the 2013 - 2018 Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for the Operators' Unit employees.

## **BACKGROUND**

During previous negotiations for the 2013 – 2018 MOU for the General Unit, the Agency agreed to allow unit members the option of earning compensatory time in lieu of monetary on-call compensation. Subsequent to the negotiations' meetings, the Operators' Unit made a similar request to allow their unit members with the same option. At that time, Agency representatives agreed to extend the benefit to the Operators' Unit; however, due to an oversight, the appropriate language was not incorporated into the Operators' MOU.

The Operators' Unit recently brought to the Agency's attention that the option of earning compensatory time in lieu of on-call pay was not being applied to their unit members. In order to implement this option, an amendment to the Operators' Unit MOU is necessary.

Upon the Board's approval, Section 8.13 of the MOU shall be amended to add a Subsection E as follows:

"Regular and probationary unit employees shall have the option of earning compensatory time, in lieu of monetary on-call compensation, at the rate equal to one hour of compensatory time for each hour of on-call pay to be taken as Adoption of Resolution No. 2015-1-2, Approving an Amendment to the 2013 – 2018 MOU for the Operators' Unit Employees

paid time off. Selection of compensatory time vs. on-call pay shall be made by the employee at the time he/she submits his/her timesheet. This provision shall be subject to all limitations and restrictions relating to the accrual and use of compensatory time as set forth in this Section."

Additionally, Section 8.16 shall be amended to add a Subsection G as follows:

"In lieu of monetary compensation, on-call pay may be added to compensatory time (see Section 8.13E).

In order to facilitate this change, a Side Letter of Agreement between the Agency and the Operators' Unit Employees was signed and agreed upon. With the approval of Resolution No. 2015-1-2, the effective date of the Side Letter of Agreement shall be February 1, 2015.

Approval of this change does not have an impact on the maximum accrual rate of compensatory time which is currently limited to 40 hours per calendar year.

The amendment to the Operators' Unit MOU is consistent with the Agency's *Workplace Environment* business goal to be committed to providing a positive workplace environment by recruiting, retaining and developing a highly skilled team dedicated to the Agency's Mission, Vision, and Values.

# PRIOR BOARD ACTION

On September 4, 2013, the Board of Directors adopted Resolution No. 2013-9-3, approving the MOU for the Operators' Unit.

The Inland Empire Utilities Agency (Agency) and the Operators' Association, Operators' Unit (OP) have agreed to the following amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) which is in effect September 1, 2013 through June 30, 2018.

Section 8.13 is hereby amended as follows to add Subsection E:

E. Regular and probationary unit employees shall have the option of earning compensatory time, in lieu of monetary on-call compensation, at the rate equal to one hour of compensatory time for each hour of on-call pay to be taken as paid time off. Selection of compensatory time vs. on-call pay shall be made by the employee at the time he/she submits his/her timesheet. This provision shall be subject to all limitations and restrictions relating to the accrual and use of compensatory time as set forth in this Section.

Subsection E above shall be effective February 1, 2015.

Section 8.16 is hereby amended as follows to add Subsection G:

G. In lieu of monetary compensation, on-call pay may be added to compensatory time (see
