The Inland Empire Utilities Agency Seats Board Members and Elects Officers

Inland Empire, California – Gene Koopman, Steven J. Elie, and Jasmin A. Hall were sworn in at the Board of Directors meeting on December 17, 2014.

Koopman begins his fourth four-year term in office, Elie begins his second four-year term in office, and Hall begins her first full four-year term in office after being appointed in October 2013.

Gene Koopman, who has served on the Board since 1998, represents the city of Ontario, the unincorporated Agricultural Preserve, and a portion of the unincorporated territories in the city of Fontana's sphere of influence. Steven J. Elie, who has been on the Board since 2010, represents the cities of Chino and Chino Hills. Jasmin A. Hall, who has been on the Board since 2013, represents the city of Fontana, and portions of Rialto and Bloomington.

At the January 21st Board of Directors meeting, the Inland Empire Utilities Agency Board of Directors held its election of officers. Director Terry Catlin was re-elected to serve another two-year term as the Board President. Director Michael Camacho was re-elected to serve as the Board Vice President, as well as its representative to the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California's Board of Directors. The Board also re-elected Director Steven J. Elie to serve as the Board Secretary/Treasurer.

"We look forward to continuing to work with a dedicated and active Board of Directors whose leadership and initiative aid in upholding the Agency's mission and vision," stated IEUA General Manger P. Joseph Grindstaff.

The Inland Empire Utilities Agency covers 242-square miles, distributes imported water, provides industrial/municipal wastewater collection and treatment services, and other related utility services to more than 830,000 people through its member agencies which include Chino, Chino Hills, Cucamonga Valley Water District, Fontana, Fontana Water Company, Montclair, Monte Vista Water District, Ontario, and Upland.
