
Request to Store Water Under Groundwater Storage Program Funding Agreement No. 49960

Recent hydrologic conditions have led to surplus water conditions for the Metropolitan Water District of Southern California (Metropolitan). As a result, Metropolitan would like to store water in the Chino Basin under the existing Groundwater Storage Program Funding Agreement No. 49960 (Agreement) during the remainder of fiscal year 2016-17 which ends June 30, 2017. Although Metropolitan may store up to 25,000 AF per year upon 15-days notice under the Agreement, Metropolitan acknowledges the limited time remaining in fiscal year 2016-17 and would like to work with your agencies to store up to 6,000 AF before the end of this fiscal year, on a best-efforts basis.
