Bird Bingo

Kindergarten-3rd Grade

Objective

To introduce students to identifying birds through observation and differences in appearance and characteristics.

Overview

Students will learn how to identify a variety of bird species found at the wetlands, including a discussion of local, migratory and invasive birds. Students will participate in "Bird Bingo," where students are given a bingo sheet and attempt to identify birds that are discussed.

Note: This activity correlates with the Wildlife Observation Study / Nature Walk.
