## **CBP | WSIP Status Update**

- Development of a better program addressing local agency needs and concerns
- Iterative refinement process with continued stakeholder engagement
- Metropolitan Water District of Southern California
  - Individual outreach to Metropolitan member agencies
  - Letter of support from Metropolitan for CWC Pending
- Local stakeholder coordination and outreach
  - Individual meetings to discuss evolution of program
  - Responding to requests from "Regional Water MOU agencies" for Baseline IEUA Permit compliance needs study conducted by Stetson Engineering
- California Water Commission
  - Early Funding Request prepared for May



## **CBP | WSIP Evolution**

### CBP | WSIP Then

- 100% external supplies as water source for CBP
- IEUA's State performance coupled with pump back into MWD system

Export of water

### CBP | WSIP Now

- Unused recycled water within basin and external supplies
- Decouple Performances
  - Metropolitan and State
  - IEUA and Metropolitan
    - New conjunctive use program with Metropolitan
    - Hybrid of in-lieu and pump back
- Hybrid approach strengthens local resilience and creates reliability by complementing imported supplies
