

2022 Emergency Water Conservation Program (EWCP)

- IEUA Allocated a 12% Reduction to each Connection





IEUA Outperforms 2022 Allocation of -12% by Additional -22%






Initial 2023 Table A Allocation Anticipated to be 5%






IEUA Imported Water Reduced by Up to 60% in 2023





Due to Severity of Anticipated Imported Water Reductions in 2023, IEUA Must Consider Multiple Factors When Allocating to Customer Agencies





Depth of Shortage Impacts Allocation Approach

Shallow water shortage

Reductions set evenly

Deep water shortage

- Needs at the retail level considered
- Primary aim is to minimize impacts to the regional economy
- Recognizes local resource development

HH&S Supplies Determination

- Based on Survey Completed by IEUA's Customer Agencies
 - Customer Agencies Represent Improvements in Ability to Access Local Supplies to Meet Basic HH&S Demands
- Ability to Petition DWR for Additional HH&S Later, if Needed

Assuring Minimum Treatment Plant Flows and Groundwater Blending Needs are Met

- IEUA advocating factors Minimum
 Treatment Plant Flows and any blending requirements into the methodology for how MWD allocates WSDM Supplies
- Some concerns with wells potentially going offline if sufficient imported water supplies are not available for blending
- Opportunities exist for requesting additional HH&S supplies if needed

MWD Board Establishes 2023 EWCP for SWP-D Member Agencies

December 21

IEUA Board Establishes 2023 EWCP for IEUA Retail Agencies January 1, 2023
New EWCP in effect

March/April 2023

MWD's Non-SWP-D Member Agencies begin Allocation under WSAP

EWCP = Emergency Water Conservation Plan **WSAP** = Water Shortage Allocation Plan **SWP-D** = State Water Project Dependent
