The meeting comes to order at the call of the Chairman.

On motion of Supervisor Cunningham, seconded by
Supervisor Mason, the following resolution is adopted and
order made:

WHEREAS, on the 17th day of April, 1950, there was
filed with this Board a petition proposing the organization of the
Chino Basin Municipal Water District within the boundaries des-
cribed in said petition and as hereinafter described, pursuant to
the provisions of the Municipal Water District Act of 1911 (Act
5243
~~5233~~ Deering's General Laws; Statutes 1911, p. 1290, as amended);
and

WHEREAS, this Board, by resolution duly adopted on the
said 17th day of April, 1950, determined that said petition com-
plied with all the requirements of said Act, was signed by the
requisite number of qualified signers and had been published for
the times and in the manner required by law, prior to the filing
of said petition, and ordered a special election to be held within
said proposed district on the 6th day of June, 1950, to determine
whether or not said district should be organized; and

WHEREAS, notice of such election was given for the time
and in the manner required by law, as shown by the Affidavits of
Publication on file with this Board; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the satisfaction of this Board
that said election was duly held at the time and at the places

specified, and in accordance with law, as shown by the election returns of said election officers as presented to this Board; and

WHEREAS, this Board has this date made an official canvass of said election returns as required by law;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board hereby finds and declares that there were 13,787 votes cast at said election on said proposition of the organization of said Chino Basin Municipal Water District with the following results:

IT IS FURTHER FOUND, RESOLVED, DECLARED and ORDERED, that in accordance with said official canvass, said district was duly formed and organized and that all of the following described territory be and the same is hereby formed, organized and incorporated into a municipal water district to be known as the Chino Basin Municipal Water District, to-wit:

PARCEL NO. 1

Beginning at the intersection of the westerly prolongation of the center line of that portion of 24th Street extending westerly from the City of Upland, San Bernardino County, State of California, with the County boundary line between Los Angeles and San Bernardino Counties;

thence easterly along said westerly prolongation and along said center line of 24th Street, to the northwest corner of the corporate limits of said City of Upland;

thence easterly along the northerly boundary line of said City of Upland, and continuing along the boundary line of said City of Upland, following all its various courses, to the southeast corner thereof, said southeast corner being on the northerly boundary line of the City of Ontario in said San Bernardino County;

thence easterly along said northerly boundary line of the City of Ontario, and continuing along the boundary line of said City of Ontario, following all its various courses, to the southeast corner thereof, said southeast corner being also the intersection of the center lines of Cucamonga Avenue and Ely Street;

thence southerly along said center line of Cucamonga

1 Avenue to its intersection with the center line of
 2 Merrill Avenue, said point of intersection being also
 3 the corner common to Lots 30, 31, 34 and 35 of Section
 4 20, T. 2 S., R. 7 W., in Rancho Santa Ana del Chino,
 recorded in Book 6, page 15, of maps, Records of San
 Bernardino County;

5 thence easterly along said center line of Merrill Ave-
 6 nue to its intersection with the center line of Grove
 7 Avenue, said point of intersection being also the
 8 quarter corner common to said Section 20 and Section
 9 21, T. 2 S., R. 7 W., in said Rancho Santa Ana del
 Chino;

10 thence southerly along said center line of Grove Avenue
 to its intersection with the easterly prolongation of
 the south line of the north 254 feet of Lot 16 of Sec-
 tion 29, T. 2 S., R. 7 W., in said Rancho Santa Ana del
 Chino;

11 thence westerly along said easterly prolongation and
 12 continuing westerly along the south line of the north
 254 feet of said Lot 16 and the south line of the north
 254 feet of lots 15, 14 and 13 in said Section 29, and
 13 along the westerly prolongation of said last mentioned
 14 south line to its intersection with the center line of
 Bon View Avenue, said point of intersection being on the
 north and south center line of said Section 29;

15 thence southerly along said center line of Bon View
 16 Avenue to its intersection with the center line of Kim-
 17 ball Avenue, said point of intersection being also the
 center of said Section 29;

18 thence westerly along said center line of Kimball Avenue
 to its intersection with the center line of Sultana
 19 Avenue, said point of intersection being also the quar-
 20 ter corner common to said Section 29 and Section 30 T.
 2 S., R. 7 W., in said Rancho Santa Ana del Chino;

21 thence northerly along said center line of Sultana
 22 Avenue to its intersection with the easterly prolonga-
 23 tion of the south line of Lot 18 of said Section 30,
 T. 2 S., R. 7 W., in said Rancho Santa Ana del Chino;

24 thence westerly along said easterly prolongation and
 continuing westerly along said south line of Lot 18 and
 25 the south line of Lot 16 in said Section 30 and along
 the westerly prolongation of said last mentioned south
 26 line to its intersection with the center line of Euclid
 Avenue, having a right of way of 200 feet in width;

27 thence southerly along said center line of Euclid Avenue
 28 to its intersection with the center line of aforemen-
 tioned Kimball Avenue;

29 thence westerly along said center line of Kimball Avenue
 30 to its intersection with the center line of Chino-Corona
 Road, also referred to as Central Avenue, said Avenue
 31 lying adjacent to the northeasterly line of Block A of
 Map "D" Extension of Rancho Santa Ana del Chino, re-
 32 corded in Book 12 of Maps, page 47 and 48, Records of
 San Bernardino County;

thence northwesterly along said center line of Chino-Corona Road to its intersection with the center line of Central Avenue, said point of intersection being on the north and south center line of Section 23, T. 2 S., R. 8 W., in aforesaid Rancho Santa Ana del Chino;

thence northerly along said center line of Central Avenue to its intersection with the easterly prolongation of the south line of Lot 37 of said Section 23, T. 2 S., R. 8 W., in aforesaid Rancho Santa Ana del Chino;

thence westerly along said easterly prolongation and continuing westerly along said south line of Lot 37 to the southwest corner thereof;

thence northerly along the west line of said Lot 37 and continuing northerly along the northerly prolongation thereof to its intersection with the center line of aforementioned Merrill Avenue;

thence westerly along said center line of Merrill Avenue to its intersection with the southerly prolongation of the west line of Lot 26 of Section 23, T. 2 S., R. 8 W., in aforesaid Map "D" Extension of Rancho Santa Ana del Chino;

thence northerly along said southerly prolongation and continuing northerly along said west line of Lot 26 to the northwest corner thereof;

thence westerly along the south line of Lot 24, in said last mentioned Section 23, and continuing westerly along the westerly prolongation thereof to its intersection with the center line of First Street, said point of intersection being also on the west line of said Section 23;

thence northerly along said center line of First Street to its intersection with the easterly prolongation of the south line of Lot 16 of Section 22, T. 2 S., R. 8 W., in said Map "D" Extension of Rancho Santa Ana del Chino;

thence westerly along said easterly prolongation, and continuing westerly along said south line of Lot 16 to the southwest corner thereof;

thence northerly along the west line of said Lot 16 to the southeast corner of Lot 2 in said Section 22;

thence westerly along the south line of said Lot 2, and continuing westerly along the westerly prolongation thereof to its intersection with the center line of West Vernon Avenue, said point of intersection being on the east line of the west one-half of the northeast one-quarter of said Section 22;

thence northerly along said center line of West Vernon Avenue to its intersection with the center line of Eucalyptus Avenue, said point of intersection being on the north line of said Section 22;

thence westerly along said center line of Eucalyptus Avenue to its intersection with the southerly prolongation of the west line of Lot 60 of Section 15, T. 2 S., R. 8 W., in said Map "D" Extension of Rancho Santa Ana del Chino;

1 thence northerly along said southerly prolongation and
2 continuing northerly along said west line of Lot 60 to
the southeast corner of Lot 54 in said Section 15;

3 thence westerly along the south line of said Lot 54
4 and continuing westerly along the westerly prolongation
thereof to its intersection with the center line of
5 Norton Avenue, said point of intersection being on the
west line of the east one-half of the southwest one-
6 quarter of said Section 15;

7 thence northerly along said center line of Norton Avenue
to its intersection with the easterly prolongation of
the south line of Lot 42 in said Section 15;

8 thence westerly along said easterly prolongation and con-
9 tinuing westerly along said south line of Lot 42 to the
southwest corner thereof;

10 thence northerly along the west line of said Lot 42 to
11 the southeast corner of Lot 40 in said Section 15;

12 thence westerly along the south line of said Lot 40
13 and continuing westerly along the westerly prolongation
thereof to its intersection with the center line of
14 Pipe Line Avenue, said point of intersection being also
on the west line of said Section 15;

15 thence northerly along said center line of Pipe Line
Avenue to its intersection with the center line of
16 Edison Avenue, said point of intersection being at the
west quarter corner of said Section 15;

17 thence westerly along said center line of Edison Avenue
18 to its intersection with the southerly prolongation of
the west line of Lot 32 of Section 16, T. 2 S., R. 8 W.,
19 in said Map "D" Extension of Rancho Santa Ana del Chino;

20 thence northerly along said southerly prolongation and
continuing northerly along said west line of Lot 32 to
21 the southeast corner of Lot 18 in said Section 16;

22 thence westerly along the south line of said Lot 18
and continuing westerly along the westerly prolongation
23 thereof, to its intersection with the center line of
the abandoned right of way of Roswell Avenue lying be-
24 tween said Lot 18 and Lot 19 in said Section 16;

25 thence northerly along said center line of the abandoned
right of way of Roswell Avenue to its intersection with
26 the easterly prolongation of the south line of Lot 14
in said Section 16;

27 thence westerly along said easterly prolongation and
continuing westerly along said south line of Lot 14 and
28 along the westerly prolongation thereof to its inter-
section with the center line of Roswell Avenue, said
29 point of intersection being also the common corner to
said Lot 14 and Lots 13, 19 and 20 in said Section 16;

30
31 thence northerly along said center line of Roswell
Avenue to its intersection with the easterly prolonga-
32 tion of the south line of Lot 4 in said Section 16;

1 thence westerly along said easterly prolongation and
 2 continuing westerly along the south line of said Lot 4
 3 and along the westerly prolongation thereof to its inter-
 4 section with the center line of the abandoned right of
 5 way of East End Avenue lying between said Lot 4 and Lot
 6 5 in said Section 16;

7 thence northerly along said center line of the abandoned
 8 right of way of East End Avenue and continuing northerly
 9 along the northerly prolongation thereof to its inter-
 10 section with the center line of Schaefer Avenue, said
 11 point of intersection being also on the south line of
 12 Section 9, T. 2 S., R. 8 W., in said Map "D" Extension
 13 of Rancho Santa Ana del Chino;

14 thence westerly along said center line of Schaefer
 15 Avenue to its intersection with the southerly prolonga-
 16 tion of the west line of Lot 60 in said Section 9;

17 thence northerly along said southerly prolongation and
 18 continuing northerly along the west line of said Lot 60
 19 and along the west line of Lot 53 in said Section 9,
 20 to the southeast corner of Lot 43 in said Section 9;

21 thence westerly along the south line of said Lot 43 and
 22 continuing westerly along the westerly prolongation
 23 thereof to its intersection with the center line of
 24 McKinley Avenue, lying between said Lot 43 and Lot 42
 25 in said Section 9;

26 thence northerly along said center line of McKinley
 27 Avenue to its intersection with the easterly prolongation
 28 of the south line of Lot 10 in said Section 9;

29 thence westerly along said easterly prolongation and
 30 continuing westerly along said south line of Lot 10 and
 31 along the south line of Lot 9 in said Section 9, to the
 32 southwest corner of said Lot 9, said corner being also
 on the west line of said Section 9;

thence northerly along the west line of said Lot 9 to a
 point distant southerly 693 feet, measured along said
 west line and its prolongation, from the center line of
 Riverside Drive, said center line being coincident with
 the north line of said Section 9;

thence westerly, along a line parallel to said center
 line of Riverside Drive, a distance of 660 feet to a
 point;

thence northerly along a line parallel to the west line
 of said Section 9, a distance of 426.03 feet, more or
 less, to its intersection with the northeasterly line
 of the San Bernardino County Flood Control District
 right of way as conveyed to said District by easement
 recorded in Book 1711, page 467 of Official Records of
 San Bernardino County;

thence North 51° 26' West along said northeasterly line
 of the San Bernardino County Flood Control District
 right of way, a distance of 300.89 feet to its inter-
 section with the aforementioned County boundary line
 between Los Angeles and San Bernardino Counties;

thence northeasterly along said County boundary line, following all its various courses, to its intersection with the aforementioned westerly prolongation of the center line of that portion of 24th Street extending westerly from the City of Upland, said point of intersection being also the point of beginning.

PARCEL NO. 2

Beginning at the northeast corner of Section 33, T. 1 N., R. 5 W., S.B.B. & M., San Bernardino County, State of California;

thence westerly along the north line of said Section 33 and continuing westerly along the north line of Sections 32 and 31, said T. 1 N., R. 5 W., and along the north line of Section 36 and 35 T. 1 N., R. 6 W., S.B.B. & M., to the northwest corner of said Section 35, a distance of approximately five miles, said line lying within the traveled roadway of Highland Avenue in said County;

thence southerly along the west line of said Section 35 and continuing southerly along the west line of Section 2, T. 1 S., R. 6 W., S.B.B. & M., to the southwest corner of said Section 2, a distance of approximately two miles;

thence westerly along the north line of Sections 10 and 9, said T. 1 S., R. 6 W., to the northwest corner of the northeast quarter of said Section 9, a distance of approximately one and one-half miles, said line being also the center line of Foothill Boulevard; thence southerly along the west line of said northeast quarter to the center of said Section 9, a distance of approximately one-half mile;

thence westerly along the north line of the southwest quarter of said Section 9 to the northwest corner of said southwest quarter, a distance of approximately one-half mile;

thence southerly along the west line of said southwest quarter and continuing southerly along the west line of Sections 16 and 21, said T. 1 S., R. 6 W., to the southwest corner of said Section 21, a distance of approximately two and one-half miles, said line being approximately coincident with the center line of Etiwanda Avenue;

thence easterly along the south line of said Section 21 to the southeast corner thereof, a distance of approximately one mile;

thence southerly along the west line of Section 27, said T. 1 S., R. 6 W., to the southwest corner thereof, a distance of approximately one mile;

thence easterly along the south line of said Section 27 and continuing easterly along the south line of Sections 26 and 25, said T. 1 S., R. 6 W., and along the south line of Section 30, T. 1 S., R. 5 W., S.B.B. & M., to the southeast corner of said Section 30, a distance of approximately four miles;

thence northerly along the east line of said Section 30 and continuing northerly along the east line of Section 19, said T. 1 S., R. 5 W., to the northeast corner of said Section 19, a distance of approximately two miles;

thence easterly along the south line of Section 17 and 16, said T. 1 S., R. 5 W., to the southeast corner of said Section 16 a distance of approximately two miles;

thence northerly along the east line of said Section 16 to the northeast corner thereof, a distance of approximately one mile, said northeast corner being also the southwest corner of the corporate limits of the City of Rialto in said San Bernardino County;

thence northerly along the westerly boundary line of said City of Rialto, a distance of approximately two miles to the northwest corner thereof, said northwest corner being also the northeast corner of Section 4, said T. 1 S., R. 5 W., and being also on the San Bernardino Base Line;

thence westerly along the San Bernardino Base Line a distance of 17 feet, more or less, to the southeast corner of the aforementioned Section 33, T. 1 N., R. 5 W., S.B.B. & M.;

thence northerly along the east line of said Section 33 to the northeast corner thereof, a distance of approximately one mile, said corner being also the point of beginning.
