Staff recommends that the Board approve the total disbursements for the month of February 2024 in the amount of \$25,491,343.69.

C. ADOPT RESOLUTION NO. 2024-4-2, AUTHORIZING IEUA TO ENTER INTO A FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AGREEMENT UNDER WATERSMART: LARGE SCALE WATER RECYCLING PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEARS 2023 AND 2024

Staff recommends that the Board adopt Resolution No. 2024-4-2, authorizing IEUA to Enter into a Financial Assistance Agreement under WaterSMART: Large Scale Water Recycling Projects for Fiscal Years 2023 and 2024 for the Chino Basin Advanced Treated Recycled Water, Storage, and Production Project.

D. ADOPT POSITION OF SUPPORT ON THE SPECIAL DISTRICT GRANT ACCESSIBILITY ACT (HR 7525) (COMMUNITY & LEG)

Staff recommends that the Board:

- 1. Adopt a position of "Support" on the Special District Grant Accessibility Act (HR 7525); and
- 2. Authorize IEUA to seek co-sponsorship of the bill from members of the IEUA delegation.

E. <u>ADOPT POSITION OF SUPPORT ON THE NITRATE AND ARSENIC IN DRINKING WATER ACT</u> (COMMUNITY & LEG)

Staff recommends that the Board adopt a position of "Support" on the Nitrate and Arsenic in Drinking Water Act.

F. ADOPT POSITION ON AB 2079: GROUNDWATER EXTRACTION: LARGE-DIAMETER, HIGH-CAPACITY WELLS: PERMITS (COMMUNITY & LEG)

Staff recommends that the Board adopt a position of "Oppose unless Amended" on AB 2079 Groundwater extraction: large-diameter, high-capacity wells: permits.

G. AWARD CONTRACT FOR EDUCATION CENTER MODULAR BUILDING (COMMUNITY & LEG) (ENG/OPS/WR)

Staff recommends that the Board:

- 1. Award a contract for the procurement, installation and delivery of a modular building for the Education Center, Project No. EA24001, to Williams Scotsman, Inc., in the amount of \$278,980; and
- 2. Authorize the General Manager to execute the contract, subject to non-substantive changes.

H. <u>APPROVE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT CHANGE ORDER FOR RP3 BASIN IMPROVEMENTS</u> <u>PROJECT (ENG/OPS/WR)</u>

Staff recommends that the Board:

- 1. Approve a construction contract change order for the RP3 Basin Improvements, Project No. RW15003.05, to Metro Builders & Engineer Group LTD in the amount of \$176,501; and
- 2. Authorize the General Manager to execute the construction contract change order, subject to non-substantive changes.

I. <u>AWARD CONSULTANT CONTRACT FOR RP-4 1299 RECYCLED WATER PUMP STATION</u> <u>REHABILITATION PROJECT (ENG/OPS/WR)</u>

Staff recommends that the Board:

- Award a consultant contract for the RP-4 1299 Recycled Water Pump Station Rehabilitation, Project No. EN24007, to Stantec Consulting Services, Inc., for the notto-exceed amount of \$612,475; and
- 2. Authorize the General Manager to execute the contract, subject to non-substantive changes.
