INLAND EMPIRE, CA – In a recent release from Moody's ratings, the Inland Empire Utilities Agency (IEUA/Agency) received affirmation of the Agency's Aa2 rating, confirming a stable outlook that debt service coverage of all outstanding obligations will remain strong and confidence that financed projects will be completed as planned.
