Request for Proposal (Deesign Consulting Engineers)

Engineering designs are solicited through a Request for Proposal on a project-by-project basis either through an advertisement sent through PlanetBids or to the list of consultants currently on IEUA's master design service contact list. *The next solicitation to be added to the master list will be Fall 2024.*

Projects Under \$2 million, Emergency and Minor Construciton Projects (Contractors)

Projects are solicited through a pool of pre-qualified contractors. Contractors can be added on a bi-annual basis (odd year) by submitting a prequalification package. Notification regarding when IEUA will be seeking a list of prequalified contractors will be sent to contractors who are registered through PlanetBids. *The next solicitation to be added to the master list will be Fall 2024*

Projects Over \$2 million (Contractors)

Have a separate prequalification issued based on the project scope. *The next solicitation to be added to the master list will be Fall 2024.*

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
