**PUBLIC COMMENT**

**ADDITIONS TO THE AGENDA**

### B. APPROVE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT CHANGE ORDER FOR CCWRF ASSET MANAGEMENT AND IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Staff recommends that the Committee/Board:

1. Approve a compensable time extension change order to Garney Pacific, Inc. for the CCWRF Asset Management and Improvements Project, No. EN17006, in the amount of \$696,006; and
2. Authorize the General Manager to execute the change order, subject to non-substantive changes.

## 2. ACTION ITEMS

### A. APPROVE CONTRACT AMENDMENTS FOR SODIUM HYPOCHLORITE AND POLYMER CHEMICALS

Staff recommends that the Committee/Board:

1. Approve a contract amendment with JCI Jones Chemicals, Inc. to increase the contract amount from \$17,000,000 to a total not-to-exceed amount of \$28,000,000 (65% increase);
2. Approve a contract amendment with Solenis LLC to increase the contract amount from \$17,000,000 to a total not-to-exceed amount of \$18,100,000 (6% increase); and
3. Authorize the General Manager to execute the contract amendments, subject to non-substantive changes.

### B. APPROVE CONTRACT AMENDMENT FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES DURING CONSTRUCTION FOR RP-5 EXPANSION PROJECT

Staff recommends that the Committee/Board:

1. Approve a consultant contract amendment for additional engineering services during construction for the RP-5 Expansion, Project Nos. EN19001 and EN19006, to Parsons Water & Infrastructure Inc., for a not-to-exceed amount of \$4,757,318 increasing the contract from \$40,551,962 to \$45,309,280 (11.7% increase); and
2. Authorize the General Manager to execute the contract amendment, subject to non-substantive changes.

### C. AWARD CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SERVICES CONTRACT FOR MONTCLAIR FORCE MAIN AND RP-1 PRIMARY CLARIFIERS PROJECTS

Staff recommends that the Committee/Board:

1. Award a construction management services contract to Z&K Consultants, Inc. for the Montclair Force Main Improvements Project, No. EN21045 and RP-1 Primary Clarifiers No. 1 through No. 10 Rehabilitation Project, No. EN24032, for a not-to-exceed amount of \$1,226,092; and
2. Authorize the General Manager to execute the contract, subject to non-substantive changes.

**D. AWARD MASTER SERVICES CONTRACTS FOR AIR EMISSIONS TESTING**

Staff recommends that the Committee/Board:

1. Award master service contracts to Air Compliance & Consulting Services, Alliance Technical Group, LLC, and Montrose Air Quality Services DBA Onterris Air Quality Services, LLC for air emissions testing services for a five-year period, with the option of two one-year extensions, for a total potential contract term of seven years, for an aggregate not-to-exceed amount of \$1,500,000; and
2. Authorize the General Manager to execute the contracts, subject to non-substantive changes.
