Staff recommends that the Board:

1. Approve the Environmental Protection Agency Community Grant funding agreement for the Cybersecurity Program Improvements Project;
2. Approve the Environmental Protection Agency Community Grant funding agreement for the Advanced Water Purification Demonstration Facility; and
3. Authorize the General Manager or their designee to enter into financial assistance agreements and execute the funding agreements, and all related documents on behalf of the Agency.

D. APPROVE GRANT APPLICATION FOR UNITED STATES BUREAU OF RECLAMATION'S WATERSMART TITLE XVI WATER RECLAMATION AND REUSE PROJECTS

Staff recommends that the Board:

1. Adopt Resolution No. 2026-8-1, authorizing IEUA to enter into a financial assistance agreement under United States Bureau of Reclamation's WaterSMART Title XVI Water Reclamation and Reuse Projects for the Advanced Treatment of Recycled Water to Enhance Chino Basin Resiliency Project; and
2. Authorize the General Manager or their designee to execute the funding agreement and all related documents.

E. ADOPT POSITION ON STATE LEGISLATION (COMMUNITY & LEG)

Staff recommends that the Board ratify support on Assembly Bill 1894 (Rubio), Fish and Wildlife: Invasive Mussels: Imported Water.

F. AWARD CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR RP-1 DIGESTER NO. 5 RECOATING REPAIR PROJECT

Staff recommends that the Board:

1. Award a construction contract to Unified Field Services Corporation for the RP-1 Digester No. 5 Recoating Repair, Project No. EN22024.03, in the amount of \$836,507; and
2. Authorize the General Manager to execute the contract, subject to non-substantive changes.

Staff recommends that the Board:

1. Award master service consultant contracts to V&A Consulting Engineers, Inc., HDR Engineers, Inc., Corrpro Companies, Inc., and National Plant Services, Inc., for condition assessment services for a three-year period, with the option of two one-year extensions, for a potential contract term of five years, for an aggregate not-to-exceed amount of \$1,500,000; and
2. Authorize the General Manager to execute the contracts, subject to non-substantive changes.

B. APPROVE CONTRACT AMENDMENT FOR PROJECT MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM

Staff recommends that the Board:

1. Approve a contract amendment with CIPO Cloud Software, Inc. for construction program management system software license, hosting service, and maintenance support, for a not-to-exceed amount of \$1,745,000, from \$856,631 to \$2,601,631 (204% increase); and
2. Authorize the General Manager to execute the contract amendment, subject to non-substantive changes.
